The Scoop:

This will be the first meeting of the 2 teams this season, however the Caliente and the Sirens did play a game during last year's regular season play. That game last season, which was also played in Sacramento, was extremely physical and both teams were extremely strong, but in the end, the Caliente were victorious over the Sirens with a score of 18-15. It was winning that game against the Sirens that earned the Caliente their birth to last year's WAFL playoffs. The Sirens then lost in the first round of playoffs to the California Quake (who went on to win the Championship), and so while the Caliente moved on to the Pacific Championship game, the Sirens would not have the opportunity to face the Caliente again and gain redemption during last year's post-season.
